- All courses are led by Cardinal Ridge staff and cost **\$65** per course per child
- Classes are from **2:25-3:25 PM** and run from March 14 - April 28, 2023

- Scholars can register for multiple classes, however, all will operate on a first come, first serve basis. Refunds will be issued if the class is full or canceled due to lack of enrollment.
- Please be mindful of the grade-level restrictions. Students who do not meet the grade requirement will not be registered.
- All classes meet once a week and are 6-weeks in length.
- Transportation needs to be provided by a parent or authorized adult. Walking home without adult supervision is not allowed. If a student is enrolled in CASA, the student will be escorted to CASA at the end of the session.

Cardinal Cheer | Grades 3-5

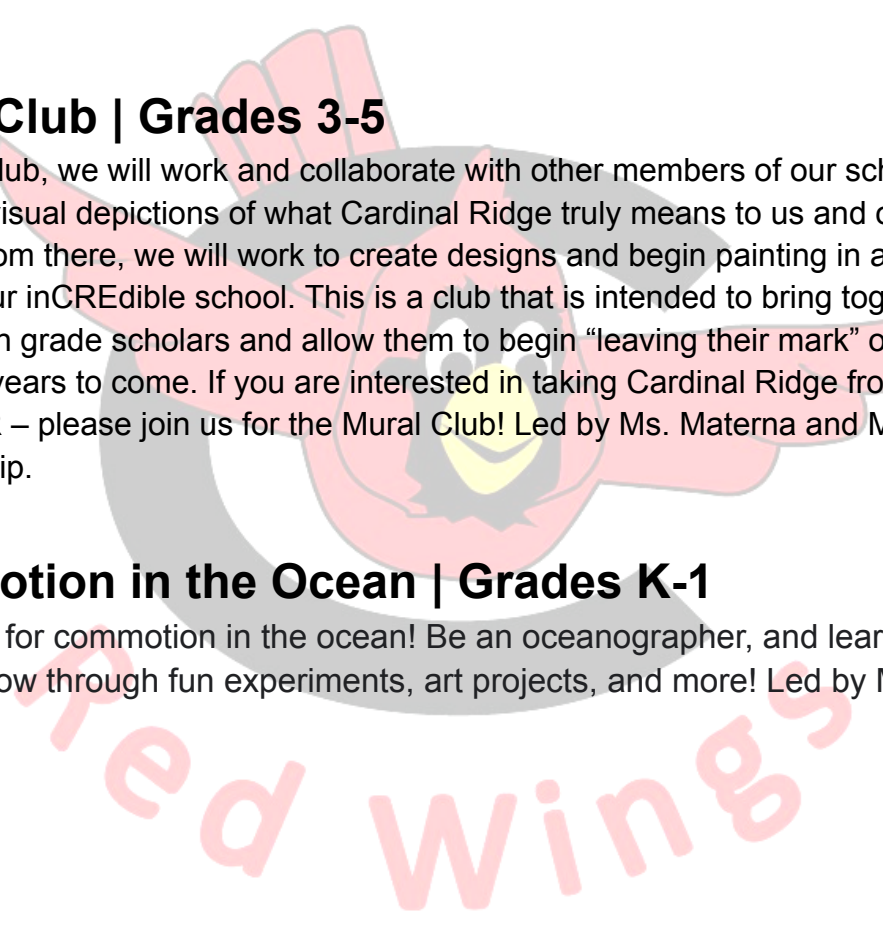
